Nomination Criteria

Nominees must be:

- Members of the Midwest Chapter at the time of nomination and for at least 3 years prior
- Nominated by a Midwest Chapter member

Nomination Requirements

Nominations must be received by **August 18, 2023** and must include:

- A completed nomination form
- A current resume or vitae of the nominee (optional)
- A letter of nomination stating why the nominee should be recognized and what specific accomplishments and achievements are pertinent
- Two additional letters of support, at least one from someone who is not employed at the nominee's institution
